INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

- The papers should include original data and they should be edited only in English, in Word, single-spaced.
- The paper should include from 4 to 8 pages (maximum), in A4 format (21 cm width and 29.7 cm height) –File-Page Setup-Paper.
- The A4 page setup should be made with the margins: Top 4.5 cm, Bottom 4.5 cm, Left 4 cm and Right 4 cm.
- The papers should be structured, so as they could include: Abstract, Key words, INTRODUCTION, MATERIAL AND METHODS, RESULTS AND DISCUSSION, CONCLUSIONS, Acknowledgments (if it is the case), REFERENCES.

The papers in their final version must comply with the following rules:

1. The following should be written with TNR 8 (Times New Roman), bold (Bold) and underline (U) on the first page (top):

The title should be written in capital letters, bold (Bold), centred, in English, after two free lines (of 10 TNR).

2. The name of the authors (both the first name and surname) should be written after one free line (10 TNR) from the title, right-centred in TNR 9, bold (Bold).

3. The name of the institution, mail address and e-mail of the author that would like to receive the correspondence should be written after a free line (of 10 TNR) from the author, centred, non-bold.

4. The Abstract should be written after a free line (of 9 TNR) with characters of TNR 10, bold (Bold), italics (Italic). The editing of the abstract should be made without bolding, but in italics, in TNR 9. The abstract should not exceed 150 words.

5. Key words should be written after one free line (of 10 TNR) in TNR 9, bold, and only maximum 6 key words should be mentioned in TNR 9, non-bold.

6. The text of the paper should be edited after a free line (of 10 TNR) from the Key words, in TNR 12, aligned at both ends (Justify).

7. All the subtitles (INTRODUCTION, MATERIAL AND METHODS, RESULTS AND DISCUSSION, CONCLUSION, REFERENCES) should be written in capital letters, TNR 10, bold, aligned to left. One free line should be left above and underneath each subtitle.

8. The tables (Table 1) and figures (Fig. 1) should be included in the text. The word „Table 1” should be written in TNR 10, italic, aligned to the right, above the title of the table. The content of the Table should be written with TNR 10 or 8. The title of the table should be written with TNR 10, centred, non- bold. The word „Fig. 1” and the explanation of the figure should be written with TNR 10 under the figure.

9. The scientific names (genus, species, etc) should be written in italic.

10. Bibliography (REFERENCES) should be written in TNR 10 and it should include the quoted authors in alphabetical order. The first author should have the surname followed by the initial of the first name, and the other authors should have the initial of the first name followed by the surname (a bibliography, such as: Aqil F., et al., 2006,..... will be not accepted). After the authors, the year of the appearance should be written between commas, followed by the title of the paper / books, the journal in which the paper is published / printing house or the place of publishing (for books), volume, its number, the first and the last page of the quoted paper. **Important: bibliography should include minimum 10 titles.**

11. In the paper, the quoted authors (that should be found in bibliography) should be written in the brackets, as it follows: if there are more than three authors, the name of the first author followed by et. al should be mentioned; if there are two authors, the name of both authors should be mentioned followed by the year of the paper's publishing.

12. The paper should be saved in a document .doc, and the name of the file should include the number of the section, followed by the letter O (in case of oral presentation) or by the letter P (in case of poster presentation), followed by the name of the first author (Examples: 6OVicas.doc; 1PVicas.doc). The papers edited according to the above-mentioned guidelines should be sent by e-mail and in a printed version to the scientific secretary of the Faculty of Environmental Protection, Prof. Eng. Cornel Domuta, PhD, as well as to the address simpozion_fpm_2010@yahoo.com as an attached file.
